- g. Nick Disability alliance feels it would be helpful to add benches or areas for rest? LM – the section currently under construction is a steep slope; this section will provide landscape for shade/wind screening and the design includes an area for rest/gathering (about halfway up). Nick – will there be benches? – LM – The section currently under construction is too steep and narrow so we won't likely be able to provide space for a bench there. I will check the final design. The rest of the path slated for construction this spring/summer will including benches and seating along the route, included in the final design.
- h. Nick What is the plan for the path to Burruss Tunnel and the entrance to Pamplin hall – LM – during construction there will be access to the accessible entry in Burruss Tunnel. The project scope connects to, but does not revise, the entrances to Pamplin hall. Nick - While the fencing is up, how will people get to that side of Pamplin. The Capital Construction group is working out options for accessible routes and phasing during construction.

- b. Soghomonian What is the procedure to request accessibility in an emergency situation where an elevator is not working? Pam Vickers spends a lot of her effort identifying alternate accommodations for faculty and staff. Also, in the Office of Equity and Accessibility Joe Cooley looks at specific concerns and compliance issues. This includes evacuation and emergency situations. A majority of our buildings were constructed before the 1990's ADA legislation. VT works on accessible solutions and modification in those buildings with various projects at every opportunity.










## SITE PLAN - OVERALL




