3. Member Reports

a. Graduate School Updates—Dean Surprenant

*Dean Surprenant introduced Dr. Barbara Hoopes, Interim Associate Dean of the Graduate School in the Washington, DC, Metro Area

*The dean thanked GPSS executive board and Rachel Maizel for their work on the compensation task force. Progress was made, but there is more to come.

*The Ombuds office will present the annual report at the next meeting.

*Current enrollment is 7145 students. This is up from 6900 from last year.

*The dean reported that 30 students were able to receive summer funding which came from an endowed fellowship (Cunningham). The chosen students were at the end of their programs and were given \$7500. Each made significant progress this summer. Five defended in August and 10 will defend in fall.

*The Supreme Court's decision on Affirmative Action means in the short term, race is hidden to anyone looking at an application. Departments can still do targeting recruitment, but they can't use race as a factor on applications. The dean reminded members to not share student information in an insecure platform.

*The dean mentioned a focus on sustainability at the Graduate School.
