

The Structure of Shared Governance

The structure of Virginia Tech's governance system consists of 13 committees, 10 commissions, five senates, University Council and University Council Cabinet, the President, and the Board of Visitors. Also included on the structure flowchart are the Department Heads Council, the Council of College Deans, and the Office of the Vice President for Policy and Governance. However, these three bodies are not part of the legislative (i.e., policy approval) process and are only responsible for consulting the legislative bodies at or below the university council level on policy considerations, or, in the case of the VP's office, facilitating the governance infrastructure.

The reporting structure, starting from the highest legislative body and working the way down, is as follows:

- **1. Board of Visitors (BOV)** overall governing authority of the university
- 2. President of the University delegated final authority on some matters by BOV
- 3. University Council advisory to the president
 - University Council Cabinet small-scale discussion forum responsible for setting and administering council business and ensuring resolutions are coming from the correct commissions based on the commission's charge
- **4. Senates** representative bodies for the constituencies of the campus community
 - Faculty Senate
 - Administrative and Professional (A/P) Senate
 - Staff Senate
 - Graduate and Professional Student Senate (GPSS)
 - Undergraduate Student Senate (USS)
- **5. Commissions** policy-recommending small groups that focus on policies related to their associated areas of expertise
 - Senate Commissions (report to a senate)

 - 2. Commission on Faculty Affairs (CFA) reports to Faculty Senate
