Resolution to Remove the Pathways Designation for Courses Not Serving Pathways

4. Reports

- Update on Pathways Stephen Biscotte: The recertification process was voted down at the end of the last academic year. The discussion on what courses are serving pathways and what courses are not serving Pathways will be brought to the Program Review subcommittee. There have been no changes to Pathways concepts and learning outcomes. The Provost has said it is imperative all Virginia Tech students are prepared for personal and professional lives with AI. The Program Review subcommittee will consider whether and how AI skills and literacy and/or critical analysis of the field might be included in the Pathways curriculum (e.g. core concept, integrative concept, courses/minor, pedagogies/assignments, etc.) and bring their insights to the committee for future discussion.
- Pathways Assessments Molly Hall: The assessment process is in year 2 of the 4 year
 assessment cycle for Pathways. Data will continue to be collected from a sampling of courses
 serving Pathways through this academic year. Year 1 of the new assessment cycle was
 successful and received positive feedback.

• Overview of Pathways – Jenni Gallagher: An overview of the Pathways program was presented for the new members of the committee. The process to review course proposals was explained to the committee. Members were asked to sign up for subcommittees.
