 - Inclusive and reflective of values
 - Operational
 - Clear and concise rules
 - Clear about reporting issues
- Where do VT's rules about conduct come from?
 - Student Code of Conduct: Honor Codes
 - Policy 1025: Protected trait discrimination
 - HR Staff policies; DHRM; other policies
 - Faculty Handbook; other policies
