- Budget Review Committee observations: 14 proposals well received. 3 proposals have support, but need more information from the Office of Sustainability. 1 proposal placed on hold pending construction project budgetary outcomes. 1 proposal is not supported. ### **Climate Action Commitment Working Group**

John Randolph: Working group is continuing. All subcommittee meetings are via Zoom. The Interim Report is finished and was delivered to Dr. Pinkney on March 4th, in which he was enthusiastic. He was asked to meet our working group meeting on Thursday. Closing the campus has hurt our community engagement plan, but that group is making alternative plans. We will ask for an extension to our deadline because of this by a few weeks to the end of May/beginning of June. Going over the Interim Report, we are putting forth aggressive sustainability measures for buildings and agricultural use with most requirements to be done by 2030. We are working extensively with power companies for improvements in our electricity use. We would like to get a donor for a signature new building that is carbon neutral. The Budget and Finance Office will be needed in pushing along our goals listed in the Interim Report. We need to create a culture of conservation on campus.
