library services is main goal currently

- Faculty have left the libraries, and students in other places are leaving the library, but quickly come back when libraries shift to an open space service model
- New pressure to justify the existence of the library
- PIBB model Performance Incentive Based Budgeting
- Deadline by May to create a plan coherent with the 5-year university strategic plan
- This task force wants to bring specific questions to this committee. Do they want to grow space, resources or services? All three; don't want to guess what the users need. How much buy-in from patrons, and from library staff? Process has been going on for 8 years or more, so staff is aware. Patrons, library must recognize and address their needs.
- Data Matters
- What's new in this place process?
 - Process is as important as the outcomes
 - Plan by user needs rather than by administrative departments
- Porter's Five Forces Framework
 - Introduce idea of competition
- Zhiwu will bring a list of potential futures for the library to the next meeting for feedback
- If librarians have deep institutional knowledge of what faculty members are working on, they can provide better services
- Jactone how do the library staff perceive this shift?
 - This process has been going on for nearly a decade, since current dean arrived
- Quiet spaces is a need that has been expressed in the past. New classroom building has a faculty lounge; it's great and well appreciated. Is the library the right place for this? Maybe, maybe not. What about such space for students? Grad students have one; it is being used.
- Jactone the need for quiet space: is it being met?
 - Considering faculty lounge, but is library the right place for it?
 - Poll the GSA about grad student perception of the library graduate student lounge what is good, what is needed
- Lisa Kennedy Does the library partner with departments to provide space for certain services? Example: map shop, where geographers/cartographers can work with other faculty members and students to create maps for publishing. There is a student that does some of this work.
